Missouri United Methodist Women Offer Free Dental Care to Children

At Court Street United Methodist Church in Fulton, Mo., local United Methodist Women members organized free children's dental screenings on April 2.

From 6-7 p.m. the doctors and their volunteer assistants had checked approximately 20 children - enough that coordinator Mary Beth Wimp could declare the event a success.

Wimp said she and her fellow United Methodist Women started offering the dental screenings five years ago because they felt it was an area of health care in which many children - especially those from more needy families - were lacking.

"Most of the parents don't have dental insurance - it's something that goes by the wayside if money is tight," she said. "Dental care is so important for children and this was a way for us to do something useful."

In addition to making the dentists available, the group also typically provides a bag containing toothbrushes, toothpaste and dental floss for each child that comes in.
