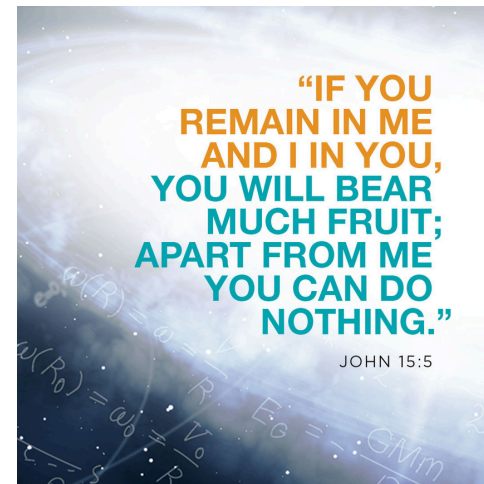
Invitation and Dedication for the Giving of Our Lives, Tithes, Gifts, and Offerings:
